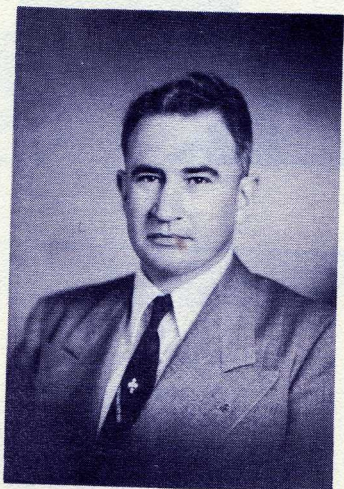

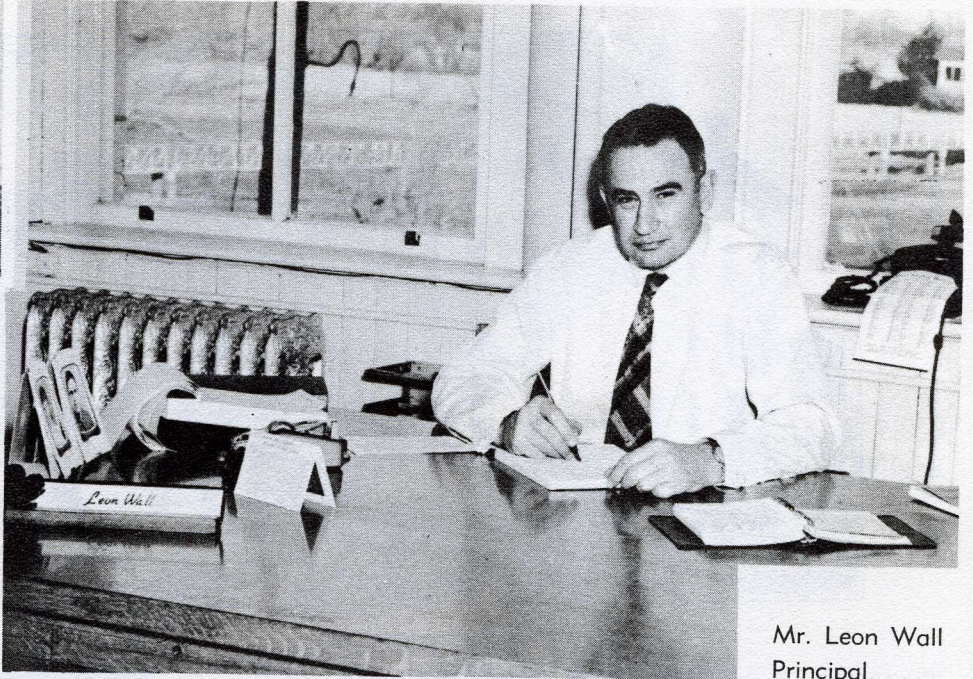

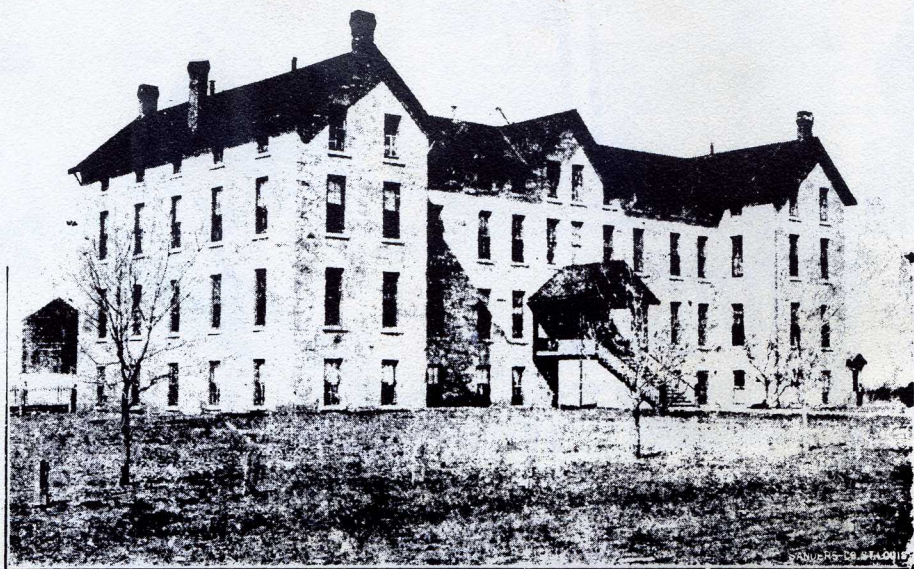

# Chilocco Founded Seventy Five Years Ago



CHILOCCO IN 1884

The Chilocco school, with W. J. Hadley, superintendent, opened its doors on January 15, 1884 to 123 children from the Kiowa, Comanche and Wichita Agency and the Cheyenne and Arapaho Agency. These children arrived in the middle of a very cold winter. They spent about a month rumbling northeast across the plains in a wagon train supervised by Mr. Frank Maltby, clerk and industrail teacher. They were forced to spend two days at a trail camp in early January because of a "norther" or blizzard. Children from other agencies nearer the school increased the enrollment to 168; thirteen were Pawnees.

The school was in one building (now Home Two) at that time. The students' rooms, the employees' rooms, classrooms, kitchen, dining room and hospital rooms were all in the large four story building made from the recently quarried magnesium limestone.

When spring came, everyone began working to break the

prairie sod for fields and gardens. A herd of cattle was purchased by the government and was herded by the larger boys until fences could be constructed. Fencing the school lands created several incidents with the stockmen who lived in the southern part of Kansas. Their stock had grazed at will on what was now school land and at night the cowboys would cut the wire fences surrounding the school.

The Appropriation Act of Congress approved May 17, 1882, stated that. "Secretary of the Interior was authorized to cause to be constructed at a point in the Indian Territory adjacent to the southern boundary of Kansas and near Ponca and Pawnee reservations and upon a section of land suitable in quality and location for the industrial purposes of the school, a building suitable in size and convenience for the instruction and care of 150 Indian children. For this purpose there was appropriated \$25,000."

Major J. M. Haworth, first superintendent of Indian Schools,

personally selected the school site, a beautiful tract of land which borders Chilocco Creek for several miles, 6½ miles south of Arkansas City, Kansas and immediately south of the Kansas border. The land is 3 miles in extent north and south and 5½ miles east and west. This tract was selected because of the type of land, nearness of a city, good water from springs along Chilocco Creek and the fact that good building stone was available near the eastern border.
