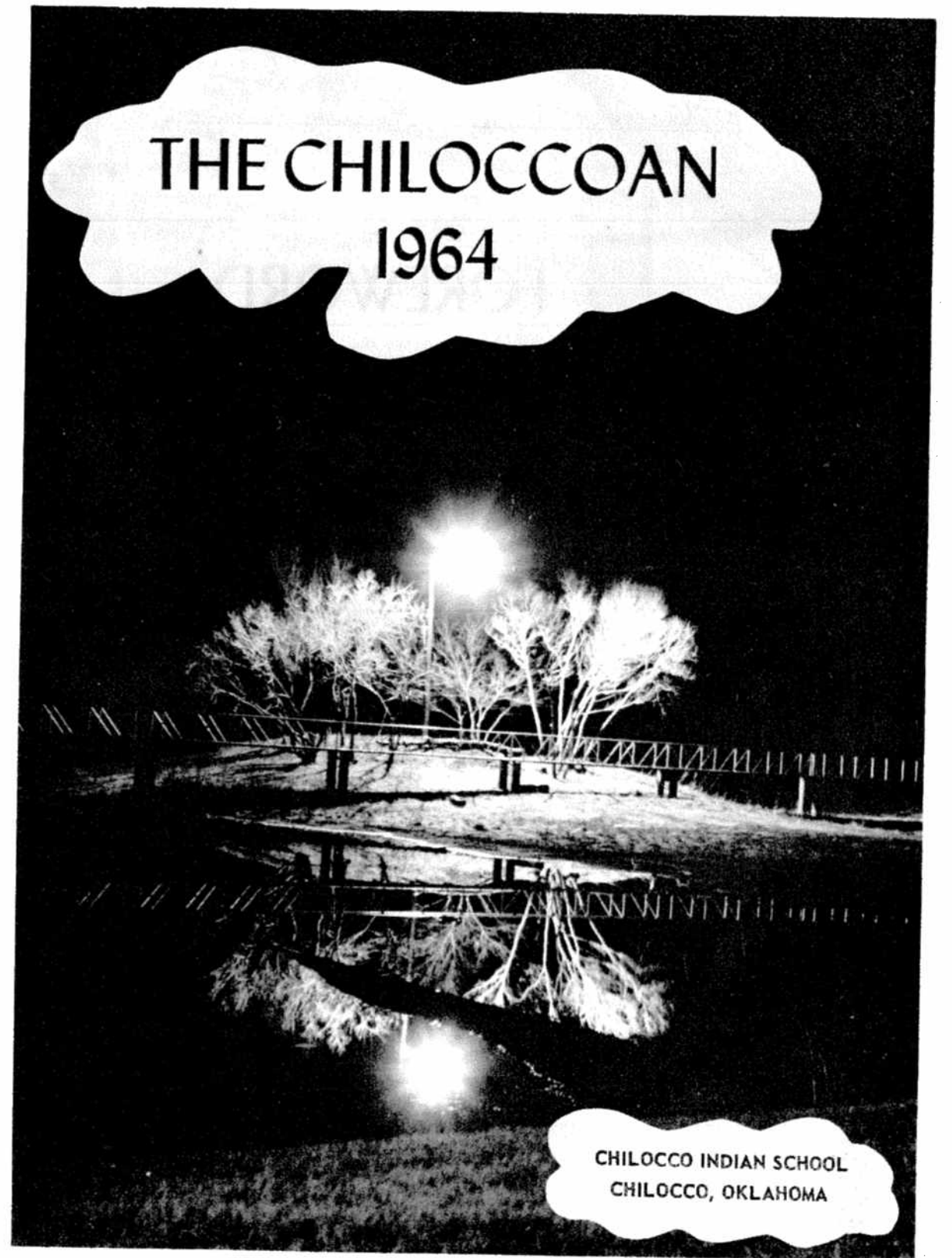

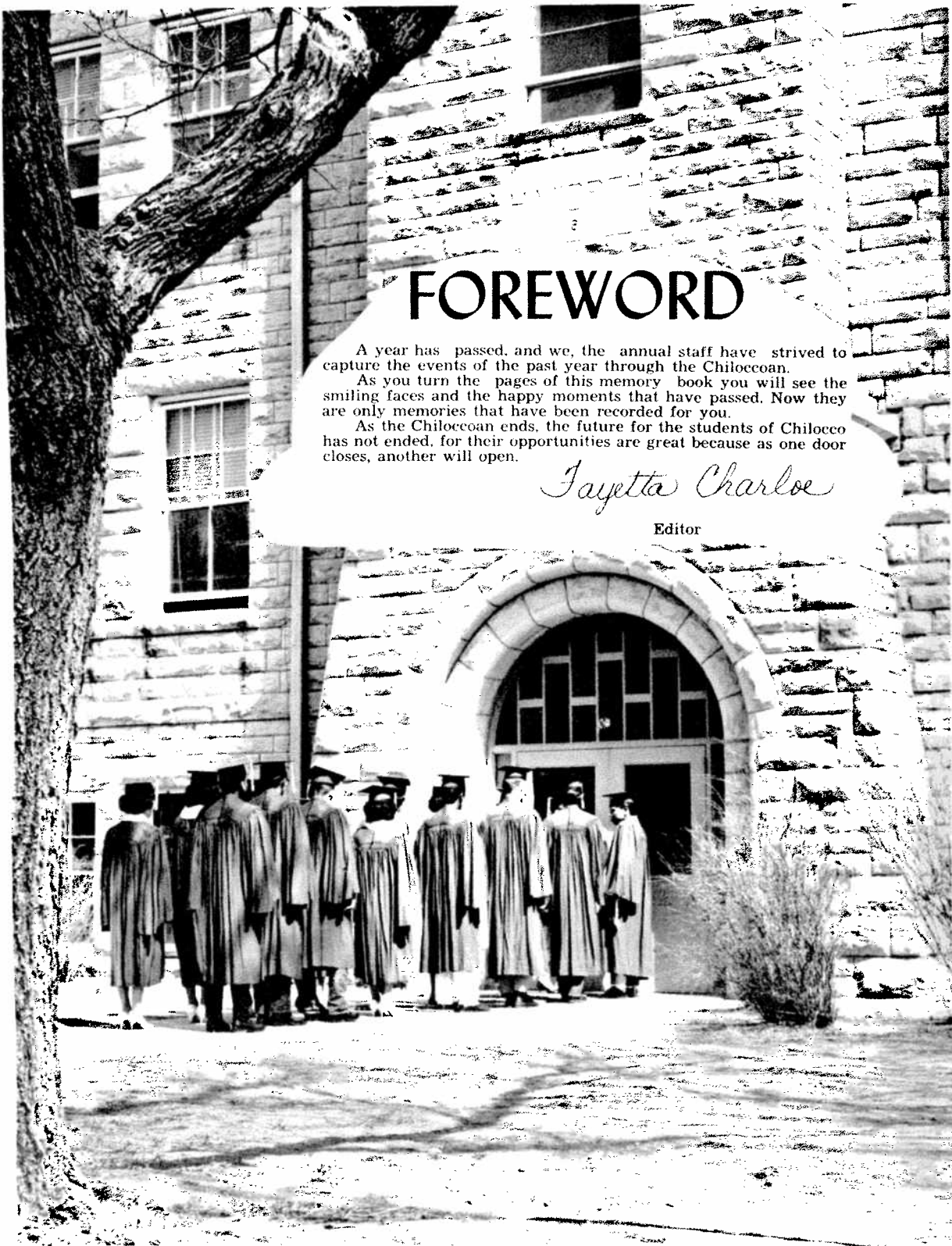

As you turn the pages of this memory book you will see the smiling faces and the happy moments that have passed. Now they are only memories that have been recorded for you.

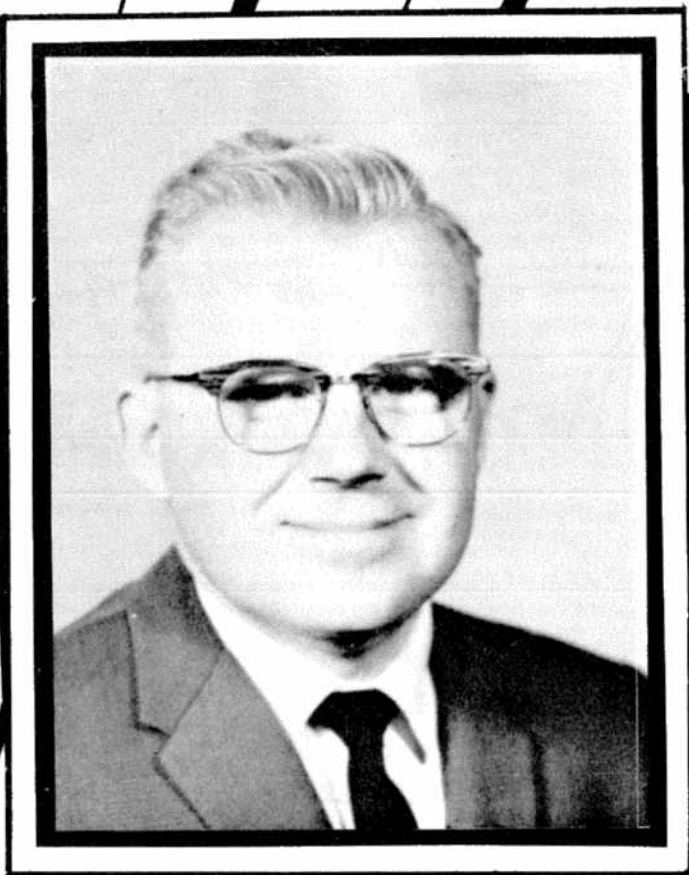
As the Chiloccoan ends, the future for the students of Chilocco has not ended, for their opportunities are great because as one door closes, another will open.

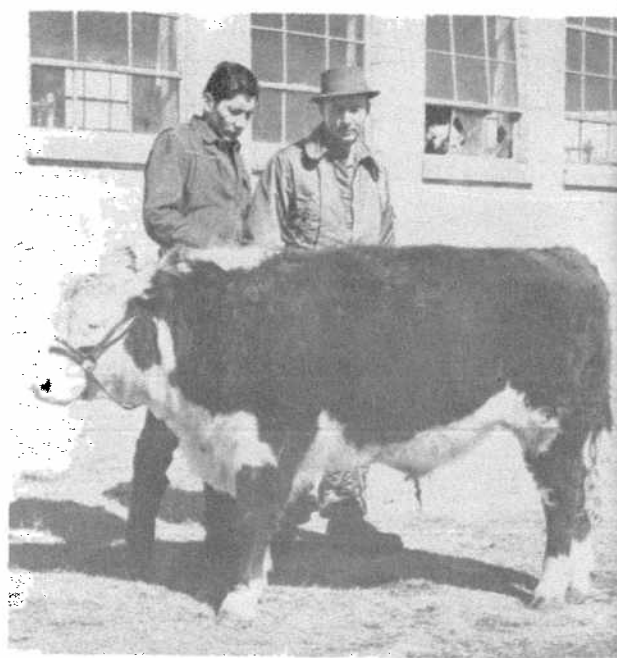
