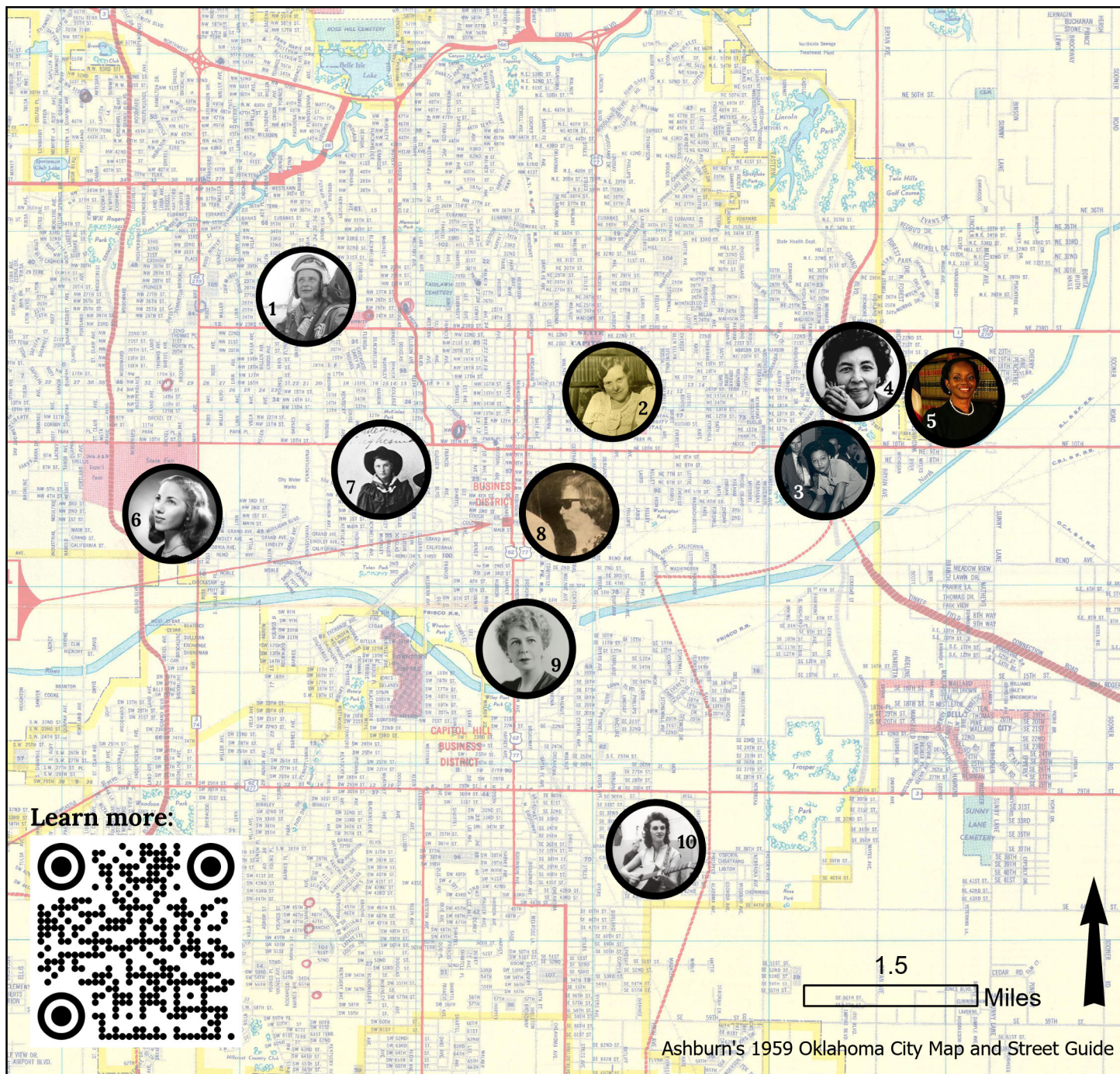




Prominent Women of Oklahoma

Oklahoma City Metro

- 1. "Jerrie" Cobb (1931-2019)**
Aviation pioneer and one of America's first female astronaut trainees in 1960.
- 2. Freda Ameringer (1892-1988)**
Publisher and activist behind the *Oklahoma Daily Leader* newspaper.
- 3. Ada Lois Sipuel Fisher (1924-1995)**
Civil rights activist and lawyer who successfully challenged segregation policy.
- 4. Hannah Diggs Atkins (1923-2010)**
First African American woman elected to the Oklahoma House of Representatives.
- 5. Vicki Miles-LaGrange (b. 1953)**
First woman to serve as U.S. Attorney in Oklahoma.
- 6. Yvonne Chouteau (1929-2016)**
Ballet dancer and one of the "Five Moons."
- 7. "Cattle Annie" (1882-1978)**
Old West outlaw who sometimes ran with the Doolin Gang.
- 8. "Rosie" Coleman Gilchrist (1910-1971)**
Civil rights activist in the 1960s.
- 9. Edith Cherry Johnson (1879-1961)**
Influential journalist and society editor for the *Daily Oklahoman* in 1908.
- 10. Wanda Jackson (b. 1937)**
The "Queen of Rockabilly," she was one of the first female rock performers (1950s).
