


Prominent Women of Oklahoma

- **1. "Jerrie" Cobb** (1931-2019) Aviation pioneer and one of America's first female astronaut trainees in 1960.
- **2. Freda Ameringer** (1892-1988) Publisher and activist behind the Oklahoma Daily Leader newspaper.
- **3. Ada Lois Sipuel Fisher** (1924-1995) Civil rights activist and lawyer who successfully challenged segregation policy.
- **4. Hannah Diggs Atkins** (1923-2010) First African American woman elected to the Oklahoma House of Representatives.
- **5. Vicki Miles-LaGrange** (b. 1953) First woman to serve as U.S. Attorney in Oklahoma.
- **6. Yvonne Chouteau** (1929–2016) Ballet dancer and one of the "Five Moons."
- **7. "Cattle Annie"** (1882-1978) Old West outlaw who sometimes ran with the Doolin Gang.
- **8. "Rosie" Coleman Gilchrist** (1910-1971) Civil rights activist in the 1960s.
- **9. Edith Cherry Johnson** (1879-1961) Influential journalist and society editor for the *Daily Oklahoman* in 1908.
- **10. Wanda Jackson** (b. 1937) The "Queen of Rockabilly," she was one of the first female rock performers (1950s).
